Ringworm Requires TLC

At too many shelters, ringworm is a death sentence. Because of this, we are currently caring for two kittens with ringworm, the adorable Lefse and her sister Perogie. A contagious fungal infection, ringworm is not deadly to people or healthy animals, but can be costly and time-consuming to treat. Due to the time required to run the full course of medication and the fact that these animals need to be cared for separately from others, shelters often kill these otherwise healthy cats and dogs.

These two lovely young ladies are currently being treated in quarantine, and after a long process of oral medication, a run of



decongestants and antibiotics to clear up kitty colds, and worming, they will be healthy enough to be spayed and made available for adoption.

S.A.R.A.'s mission has always been to rescue cats that would be euthanized in a regular shelter situation, and Perogie and Lefse are perfect examples of that. We're committed to giving all cats a chance to live a long and healthy live, <u>but we can't do it without your support</u>. Your donation ensures that we continue have the resources to care for the cats who would otherwise be killed for diseases that require a little extra time and a little extra care.
